We won court settlements with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency that will help better protect public health from asbestos

We secured \$10.3 million from the Washington state legislature for agencies to adopt health protections for harmful chemicals in everyday products

Washington's laws banning PFAS in food packaging and firefighting foam have been replicated in 9 other states, protecting drinking water and food for nearly 100 million people nationwide

Through Washington state's new PFAS in drinking water standards, our work has helped to protect more than 6 million people
